Fees

No charge is made when the nursery closes for school holidays, bank holidays or during the Christmas period. However, fees remain payable if your child is ill or on holiday. Fees must be paid four weeks in advance.

NB: Where the nursery has to close due to circumstances beyond our control, eg. adverse weather conditions, power failure etc, fees will be charged as normal.

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Supporting Children with Additional Needs

Our nursery has a Special Educational Needs & Disabilities Coordinator (SENDCO), Louise Newbury. Her role is to support children who have additional needs, helping them to reach their developmental milestones.

She will liaise with the key person and other professionals to set developmentally appropriate targets to support your child's individual development.

If needed we will carry out Individual Education Plans and coordinate children's transition in to their next setting.

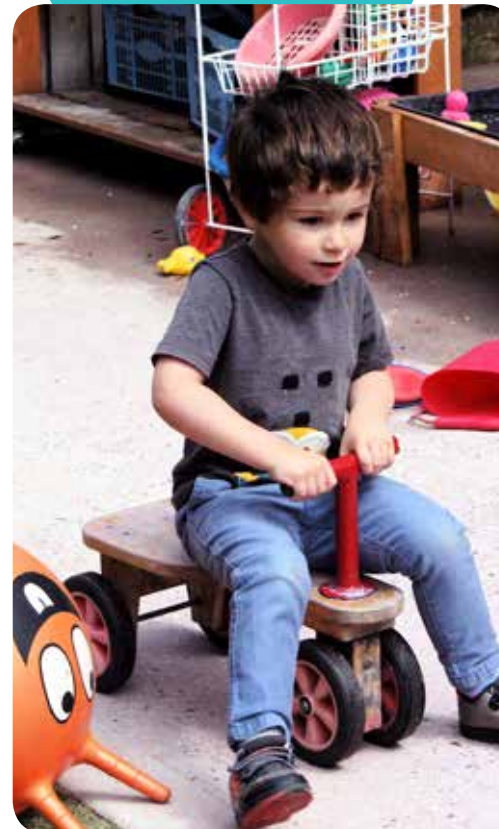


Help with Fees

Assistance towards the cost of childcare is available through the Working Families Tax Credit scheme. Please ask the Nursery Manager for details, or contact the Job Centre or the Tax Office for an application pack.

Your 2-year old may be eligible to attend these sessions FREE if your family receives certain benefits. And now families receiving working tax credit with an income of less than £16,190 are also eligible.

3-year olds are entitled to receive 15 hours of FREE childcare for the term after their 3rd birthday.



Structure

Staff child ratios in our nursery are:
1:4 (2-3 years)

1:8 (3-5 years).

Your child will have a key person, who will work alongside you and your child to ensure that your child's needs are fully met.
