Fees

No charge is made when the nursery closes for bank holidays or during the Christmas period. However, fees remain payable if your child is ill or on holiday. Fees must be paid four weeks in advance.

NB: Where the nursery has to close due to circumstances beyond our control, eg. adverse weather conditions, power failure etc, fees will be charged as normal.

Late collection

Late collection fee for every 15 minutes late after the end of the child's agreed session time £15.00

Early Education (Universal Hours) Funding

For 2, 3 and 4 year olds (15 hours only) can be used for the following sessions:

8.30am - 4.00pm

8.00am - 1.00pm or 12.00 - 5.00pm

9.00am - 12.00pm or 1.00 - 4.00pm

15 hours can be stretched throughout the year.

Extended Hours (30 hours only) can be used for:

9.00am - 4.00pm sessions only (term time only).

Supporting Children with Additional Needs

Our nursery has two Special Educational Needs Coordinators (SENDCOs), Carley Durrant and Ruby Willis. Their role is to support children who have additional needs, helping them to reach their developmental milestones.

They will liaise with the key person and other professionals to set developmental appropriate targets to support the child's individual development.

Help with Fees

Assistance towards the cost of childcare is available through the Working Families Tax Credit scheme. Please ask the Nursery Manager for details, or contact the Job Centre or the Tax Office for an application pack.

Your 2-year old may be eligible to attend these sessions FREE if your family receives certain benefits. And now families receiving working tax credit with an income of less than £16,190 are also eligible.

3-year olds are entitled to receive 15 hours of FREE childcare for the term after their 3rd birthday. Little Ducks is also able to offer 30 hours funding for 3 year olds, although there are limited places available.



Structure

Staff child ratios are:

1:3 for 0-2 year olds

1:4 for 2-3 year olds

1:8 for 3-5 year olds

Each child has a key person who will work alongside you and your child to ensure that your child's needs are fully met.
